Although the list gives names of medications most commonly prescribed within the respective drug groups, it is not a comprehensive list

<b>Drug group:</b>	<b>Medication name(s):</b>
ACE Inhibitors:	ramipril, perindopril, lisinopril
Antihypertensives:	Bendroflumethaizide, doxazosin, amlodipine
Antipsychotics:	Risperidone, olanzapine, quetiapine, aripiprazole
Barbiturates:	phenobarbitone
MAOIs:	phenelzine, moclobemide
Nitrates:	isosorbide mononitrate, glyceryl trinitrate
SSRIs:	citalopram, sertraline, fluoxetine, venlafaxine
Tricyclic antidepressants:	amitriptyline, imipramine
